

Code of Conduct Form

The Valley Youth Center believes that there are basic character traits all students must possess in order to assure that the Valley Youth Center is a safe and productive place. These traits include self-discipline, responsibility, integrity, honesty, respect, kindness, and compassion, good judgment, good citizenship, and perseverance to pursue what is right.

Valley Youth Center Students **SHALL NOT**:

- Exhibit disruptive behavior/destroy the Youth Center property.
- Speak in a way that teases, hurts or harasses others i.e. bullying, cyber bullying, facebook posts, e-mail posts, text messages that would hurt one another.
- Use inappropriate language you are a representative of the VYC and setting an impression on the younger children at the VYC.
- Act in a way that endangers the safety of themselves or others.
- Use profanity, abusive language, racial, ethnic, religious or sexually derogatory or explicit terms or obscene gestures and inappropriate words to other students.
- Act in a manner that damages the Valley Youth Center or Red Lion Gym facilities.
- No weapons of any kind allowed (scissors, blades, pen knives).
- No liquids of any kind are allowed to be brought in from the outside (water bottles, Gatorades, juice boxes). Unless your child is on a special diet, it must be cleared by the adult volunteer in charge.
- No alcohol, drugs, smoking of any kind are allowed in the VYC.

I agree to follow the rules of the Valley Youth Center. My son/daughter has my permission to attend the Valley Youth Center on the day and time that his/her grade is assigned. If any damage is done to the Valley Youth Center by my child, we are personally responsible for the cost of the repairs.
